Objectives

To plan and implement network activities with the collaboration of beneficiaries, partner organizations, researchers and external stakeholders, to exchange knowledge across disciplines, and sectors involved in the provision of A&S housing across Europe. To deliver network activities through a series of events and publications across the network.

Tasks

Task 3.1. Workshops

Three workshops will be organised to review progress of ESRs projects, and provide further exposure for ESRs to research methods and tools, and transferable skills. Workshops will be 3-days long and will have one day for ESRs presentations, one day for RMT course, and one day for TS course.

Task 3.2. Summer Schools

Three five-days summer schools will focus on three specific topics: SS1, Valencia; “Sustainable planning, design and retrofitting of housing”; SS2, Nicosia, “Inclusive co-design and community planning” and SS3, Lisbon, “Social housing innovations”. The programme of activities will enable the exchange of knowledge across ESRs, disciplines and non-academic organizations. Parallel events (exhibitions, forums) will be part of the programme.

Subtask 3.2.1 SS1:

Sustainable planning, design and retrofitting of housing (m12). This will build on theme 1 ‘Design, Planning and Building’ in order to further examine the key factors affecting sustainable housing.

Subtask 3.2.2 SS2:

Inclusive co-design and community planning (m24). This will build on theme 2 ‘Community Participation’ in order to evaluate stakeholder engagement in delivering A&S housing.

Subtask 3.2.3 SS3:

Social housing innovations (m36). This will build on theme 3 ‘Policy and Planning’ in order to assess European policies and planning approaches for A&S housing.

Task 3.3. International Conferences

Two two-days conferences will be held in Grenoble and Barcelona following on the “Global Dwelling” series dedicated to showcasing ESRs work. A scientific committee will review and select papers presented by ESRs and by external participants. The programme will include special sessions to present and discuss the network’s research. Poster sessions will be organized for ESRs to showcase their work, along with other participants, keynote speakers and plenary sessions.

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Subtask 3.3.1 IC1:

Global Dwelling: Redesigning education for A&S housing (m26). Exploring ways to change academic programmes across Europe, to develop more inclusive, open and participative housing design studios.

Subtask 3.3.2 IC2:

Global Dwelling: Transdisciplinary perspectives for A&S housing (m44). This conference will build on the content of RMT1-3 and contribution to knowledge from the ESRs projects to inform its agenda and discuss lessons learnt.
